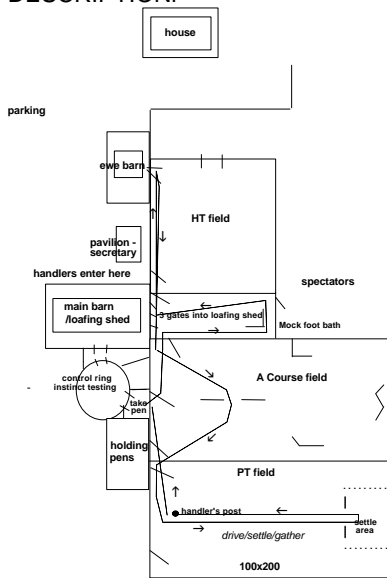

Time for course: 25 minutes for all classes. **DIAGRAM AND COURSE DESCRIPTION:**



(Not to scale)

1. **TAKE PEN** (10 points): Remove all 10 sheep from Control ring into Take Pen. Advanced: Handler must remain outside of control ring. Intermediate: Handler may step just inside control ring. Started: Handler may enter control ring and assist, but may not touch dog. Remove all 10 sheep from Take pen into A Field in a calm controlled manner. Dog should keep control of stock while moving to A Field gate.

2. **OBSTACLE 1** (15 points): Move all 10 sheep into Barn Loafing/Shed pen and allow sheep to settle while closing gate. Move all 10 sheep through Mock Foot Bath. Advanced: Handler remains at the entrance to the obstacle until all sheep have exited. Intermediate: Handler may move along the side of the obstacle to its corner, but not past the corner until sheep have exited. Started: Handler may move anywhere along the side of the obstacle. All Classes: The sheep are taken to the gates that lead into the Barn/Loafing Shed.

3. **SORT** (15 points): Gate sort 5 sheep using any of the three gates into the Barn/Loafing Shed. There are five marked sheep. Advanced: At least 4 or the 5 sheep sorted are marked. Intermediate: At least 2 of the 5 sheep sorted are marked. Started: Any 5 sheep may be sorted. Take remaining 5 sheep into the HT field. Fetch and/or drive the 5 sheep into Ewe Barn. Advanced: Pen sheep into 1 or the 2 marked stalls, shut gate and allow sheep to settle (there is a feeder that the sheep will try to go around). Intermediate: Put sheep into Ewe Barn, take them around the feeder, but not into the pens. Started: Put sheep into the Ewe Barn. All Classes: Remove sheep from Ewe Barn and return through the HT Field to the gates where the gate sort occurred. All handlers may be in the Ewe Barn when removing the sheep.

4. **OBSTACLE 2** (15 points): Remove the sheep from the Loafing Shed area, reuniting the group. Take the sheep to the A Course, across the A Course and through the Center Line Panels, then to the gate into the PT Field. Advanced and Intermediate handlers may not go through the panels. Started handlers may go through the panels.

5. **OBSTACLE 3** (15 points): The sheep are taken around the Handler's Post with the post on their left as indicated in the diagram. They are driven from the Handler's Post through the panels at the far end of the arena. Advanced: Handler remains at post until the sheep clear the panels. Intermediate: Handler may accompany sheep halfway to the panels, but remains at that point until the sheep clear the panels. Started: Handler may accompany the sheep to the panels but may not go through them. Started: Handler may accompany the sheep to the panels but may not go through them.

6. **SETTLE/GATHER** (20 points): The sheep are settled and held for one minute. The sheep should not leave the settle area and neither the handler nor dog should enter it. Advanced and Intermediate handlers may move closer to the settle area if desired. At a signal from the judge, the sheep are gathered. Advanced: Handler and dog leave the sheep and return to the Handler's Post. The sheep should come around the handler's post with the post on their right as indicated on the diagram. Intermediate: Handler and dog return to a point halfway between the Handler's Post and the panels. Started: the handler and dog return to a point halfway between the Handler's Post and the panels, but the handler may move back closer to the panels before sending the dog.

7. **RE-PEN** (10 points): The sheep are moved back into the A Course and returned to the Take Pen.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

TEST TRIAL LOCATION GROUNDS ARE AVAILABLE FROM 6 30 AM to conclusion of event. Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition. There is some shade for dogs and water is available. Bring your own crates, canopies, chairs, towels, etc. Bring appropriate wear for weather.

NO UNENTERED DOGS (EXCEPT SET-OUT DOGS) WILL BE ALLOWED AT THE TEST/TRIAL SITE. All dogs present must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when working stock. Under NO circumstance will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Any dogs aggressive to persons or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the American Kennel Club *HERDING REGULATIONS*).
