EXHIBITORS and HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and for cleaning up after their dogs.

DOGS SHOULD BE PRESENT in ample time before their scheduled judging time and they may be removed as soon as they are no longer needed for competition. Once brought into the grounds, a dog entered in this show may not be withheld from competition unless excused by a Judge, Veterinarian or the Show Committee.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance to the judging ring when the class is scheduled to be judged. Only dogs eligible to be shown under the American Kennel Club Rules are allowed in the show precincts.

THE MANAGEMENT will exercise every precaution for the safety of the dogs exhibited and it is understood that neither the club nor the management nor the landlord will be responsible for the loss of, damage to, or any other damage caused by any dog for any cause.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE will use due diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in the show.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is the responsibility of the exhibitor, who must exercise control and restraint over the child while the child is on the show premises.

EXHIBITORS should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

EVENT RULES

ALL DOGS shall be held on leash at the show grounds. There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. The use of corrective devices is strictly prohibited on the show grounds. Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities or building/ parking regulations.

PLEASE NOTE: Entries must not specify any condition of acceptance. **Entries requiring a signature of receipt WILL NOT be accepted.** Be sure to authorize waiver for signature when sending [overnight] FedEx, USPS or UPS

Make checks and money orders payable to: GERMAN SHEPHERD DOG CLUB OF ALASKA, INC. (GSDC of AK). NSF or returned checks require cash payment of entry fee plus \$35.00 NSF fee.

To be acceptable an entry must be submitted with the required entry fee and signature on an official AKC entry form. Changes must be received in writing or email prior to closing time.

(The club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for the American Kennel Club per Rules Applying to Dog Shows: recording fees are \$.50 per first entry of each dog and Event Service Fees are \$3.00 per entry. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes and multi-dog classes).

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTERING DOGS

Select the classes for which your dog is eligible then fill out the entry completely. Please TYPE or PRINT clearly; proper spelling in the catalog depends on your clear printing!

Entry in a conformation class is not required for entry in a Sweepstakes or Non-regular classes, unless otherwise noted.

PLEASE remember to include only AKC Titles and OFA numbers
(all titles/certificates are welcome in your ads!)

OFA numbers are permitted in the show catalog; the complete numbers should be written on the entry form following the name of the dog.

Conformation - Regular Classes

The Puppy Classes are divided and shall be for dogs that are six months of age and over, but under nine months; and for dogs that are nine months of age and over, but under twelve months, that are not champions. The age of a dog shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the first day of a show.

The Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class shall be for dogs that are twelve months of age and over, but under eighteen months, that are not champions. The age of a dog shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the first day of a show.

The Novice Class shall be for dogs six months of age and over, which have not, prior to the date of closing of entries, won three first prizes in the Novice Class, a first prize in Bred-by-Exhibitor, American-bred, or Open Classes, nor one or more points toward their championships.

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

The American-Bred Class shall be for all dogs (except champions) six months of age and over, whelped in the United States of America, by reason of a mating which took place in the United States of America

The Open Class shall be for any dog six months of age or over except in a member specialty club show held only for American-bred dogs, in which case the Open Class shall be only for American-bred dogs.

Conformation NON-REGULAR CLASSES:

Veteran Classes - For dogs/bitches seven-ten years of age or 10+ years of age and older.

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and at least two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. The Get must be entered in the show in a regular class. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Class - For Brood Bitches and at least two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not be owner of the Produce. The Produce must be entered in the show in a regular class. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce.

Brace Class - For two German Shepherd Dogs with at least one common owner. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1, Brace No. 2," etc. on the entry form.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
