

POINT SCHEDULE:

Below is the schedule of points for the ATAA program – new titles are being implemented each year by AKC and other venues, there are just too many to be listed. As a result when new titles are added they will be placed in the appropriate category and receive points accordingly.

AKC Obedience Title –

- 5 points - Companion Dog (CD), Beginner Novice (BN), Graduate Novice (GN), Versatile Companion Dog (VCD 1,2,3) Coursing (CA, CAA, CAX etc....), Therapy Dog (THD)
- 10 points – Graduate Open (GO)
- 15 Points - Companion Dog Excellent (CDX) , Versatility (VER)
- 20 Points - Obedience Master 1 to 10 (OM1, OM2, etc.), Utility Dog Excellent 2,3 etc,
- 30 Points - Utility Dog (UD) ,Obedience Grand Master (OGM)
- 40 Points - Utility Dog Excellent (UDX)
- 60 Points - Obedience Trail Champion (OTCH)

AKC Tracking Titles

- 10 Points - Tracking Dog (TD)
- 25 Points - Tracking Dog Excellent (TDX)
- 30 Points - Variable Surface Tracking (VST)
- 30 Points – Champion Tracker

AKC Rally Titles

- 5 Points – Rally Novice (RN)
- 10 Points – Rally Advanced (RA) , Rally Advanced Excellent 2,3 etc (RAE2, RAE3)
- 15 Points – Rally Excellent (RE)
- 20 Points – Rally Advanced Excellent (RAE)

WDA/DVG/USCA Degrees

- 5 Points - Begleithunds (BH) , Ausdauerprüfung (AD)
- 15 Points - Schutzhund I (SchH I), WD1, IPOI, VPGI
- 25 Points - Schutzhund II (SchH II), WD2, IPOII, VPGII , Fahtenhund (FH), FH2
- 40 Points - Schutzhund III (SchH III) , WD3, IPOIII, VPGIII

AKC Herding Titles

- 5 Points - Herding Tested (HT)
- 15 Points - Pretrial Tested (PT)
- 20 Points - Herding Started (HS)
- 25 Points – Herding Started Master (HSM)
- 30 Points - Herding Intermediate (HI)
- 35 Points – Herding Intermediate Master (HIM)
- 40 Points - Herding Excellent (HX)
- 45 Points – Herding Excellent Master (HXM)
- 60 Points - Herding Champion (Hch)

AKC Agility Titles

- 5 Points – NA, NAP, NF, NFP, NAJ, NJP
- 10 Points – OA, OAP, OF, OFP, OAJ, OJP
- 15 Points - AXJ, AJP ,MX2, MX3 MJ2, MJP3...
- 20 Points – AX, AXP, XF, XFP
- 25 Points – MXJ, MJP ,PAX
- 30 Points – MX, MXP, MXF, MFP, Master Agility Champion 2,3 (MACH2, MACH3)
- 60 Points - Master Agility Champion (MACH)

GSDC of America Title

- 25 Points – Champion with performance title – Dual Award
- 25 Points – Champion with performance title, certified hip & elbows, TC, Dual Award Excellent
- 25 Points – Obedience Victor/Victrix- Herding Victor/Victrix – Agility Victor/Victrix
- 30 Points – Performance Award of Merit - PAM

Titles from **All Performance** events will count towards points starting with 2009. ie...New AKC titles, UKC, USDAA, NADAC etc.....

These dogs must follow the same guidelines as other participants. They must be pure bred, no disqualifying faults and a conformation ribbon or letter from a judge attesting to that fact. Breeders must be members of the Parent club or have made application. These new venues will be broken down into 4 categories as follows:

- 5 points - Level I, Beginner, Novice
- 15 points - Level II, Open, Advance
- 20 points – Level III, Master, Excellent
- 30 points – Championships

When filling out your form and listing the titles other than AKC it is up to YOU to note beside each title which LEVEL the title is. If you don't, the chair will award points as she sees it and that will stand.

Working dog

These titles are for the working dogs of our breed. The sire and dam will receive 40 points for the first certification earned in whatever category and receive 20 points for the second certification and 10 points for any subsequent certifications. Listed below are the categories, sub-categories will no longer be listed, you must provide a valid certificate for each title.

These dogs must follow the same guidelines as other participants. They must be pure bred, no disqualifying faults and a letter from a judge attesting to that fact. Breeders must be members of the Parent club or have made application. They must send a copy of the certification at the time of submission. Certifications recognized will be National, State and local (city or county).

Points are deliberately weighted much higher for the advanced titles/degrees to encourage people to continue training their dogs after obtaining a basic title/degree and to recognize the dogs that are able to obtain the more difficult titles/degrees.
