

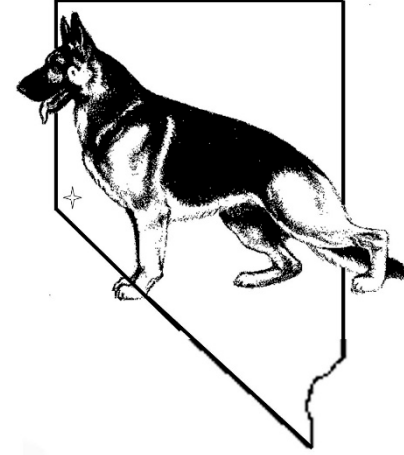

Dogs must be ready for judging at show time or when the class is called. The club and the Show Secretary will not be responsible for and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

Dogs need to be at the shows only at the scheduled times of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

Canadian exhibitors will please make all checks and money orders payable in U. S. Funds.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control of their children and dogs on the days of the show and on the show grounds. Thank you for your cooperation.

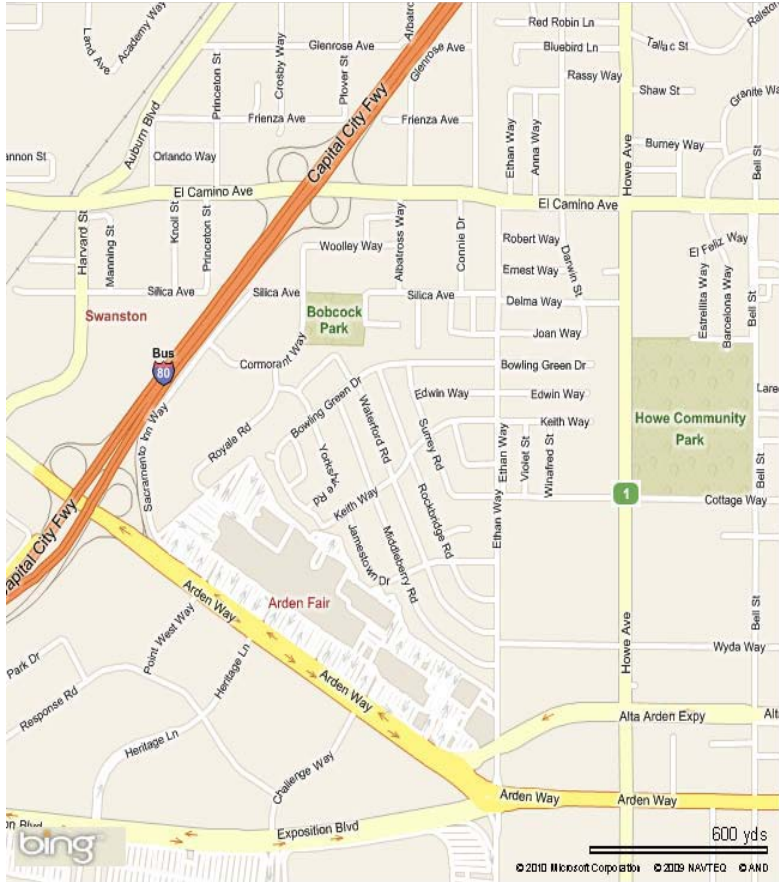
