ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

These shows are governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the entry form in the premium list. Entries submitted must include both sides of the entry form.

A Recording Fee and Event Fee will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry.

Telegraph, Telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms, and photocopies of Entry Forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Forms are not acceptable.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. Fees must accompany entries. The GSDCSTL/or its superintendent assume no responsibility for incorrect or incomplete information given on the entry form by the owner or agent of the owner. The GSDCSTL and its superintendent assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice.
- 2. Entry fees will NOT be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of the entry fee for bitches in season; bitches entered for breed competition are eligible to be shown. There is no refund for duplicate entries.
- 3. Declination of entries. The GSDCSTL may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the kennel clubs or any official thereof.
- 4. Effective for all shows held on or after April 30, 1980, dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour before the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUDGING

- 1. Judging will start promptly. During the hours of judging, owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only to be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. DO NOT BRING ANY DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED. There is no provision for unentered dogs at these shows.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners or agents of the dog alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. There is no rule that requires the judge to wait for a late dog.
- 3. All dogs must be on leash at all times while on the show premises, except when in an exercise pen.
- 4. All prizes will be awarded in the ring. The German Shepherd Dog Club of St Louis reserves the right to substitute any trophy with one of equal or greater value if conditions make it necessary.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

- 1. MANAGEMENT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LOSS OF, DAMAGE TO, OR DEATH OF ANY DOG EXHIBITED, OR FOR THE POSSESSIONS OF ANY PARTICIPANT, WHETHER THE RESULT OF ACCIDENT OR ANY OTHER CAUSE. - 2. DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.
- 3. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children while they are on the show premises.

- 3. ALL EXHIBITORS AND AGENTS must keep dogs under control, restrained at all times.



Open Junior Class - For boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won (3) first places in a Novice class with competition present at a licensed or members show.

Open Intermediate Class - For boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won (3) first places in a Novice class with competition present at a licensed or members show.

4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

The 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition is open to all German Shepherd Dogs and shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months of age on the day of the Show. This will be one class with no separation of sex. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol. Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. Judges will comply with the Rules, Policies and Guidelines for Conformation Judges except the speed of judging may be reduced to 20 dogs an hour. Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition may be offered in a separate ring(s) from the regular class judging in order to avoid delays in the judging of regular classes. Entry fees will be determined by the show-giving club and no recording or event service fees will be charged for this competition. Clubs holding Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition will receive credit for completing both a Major Activity as well as an Additional Activity for judges gaining experience on their unapproved breeds by judging at the event. Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Entries Close at the office of the Show Secretary at 6:00P.M. (CST), April 27, 2019. Entry fee is \$18.00.

- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner if any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
