The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class for children 5–9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern. Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child accompanied by a responsible adult and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- *A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class and a German shepherd dog. All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar. Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.*
- *A responsible adult must be present with the child in and out of the ring. The adult must hold the dog's leash and maintain control of the dog while outside of the ring.*
- **Entries will be taken ringside** before the Saturday morning event during the 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of judging. See the Event Secretary outside the conformation ring.

JUDGES BIOGRAPHIES

Mr. Sam Israel - Bio

I have owned and lived with German Shepherd Dogs my entire life. I started to show German Shepherds in 1993 when I purchased the pick of the first litter sired by Ch. Jericho's Gatineau. I have attended almost all nationals since 1994, and have shown dogs in several of our National shows. I have bred and owned multiple champions and have shown my dogs throughout the US, although mostly on the west coast. I usually have engaged professional handlers for my dogs but have handled almost all of my dogs in the show ring and have put points on most of my dogs. I have been a member of the German Shepherd Dog clubs of Los Angeles (prior President), San Gabriel Valley, and Santa Maria, and some others. I was also on the board of directors and was the treasurer of the Beverly Hills Kennel Club. I obtained my judges license at the end of 2016 and judged my first show in January 2017. Since obtaining my judges license, I have judged about 13 shows throughout the United States (from Florida to Hawaii) and have judged both specialty shows and all breed shows.

Dr. Firouz Shahrokhi PhD – Bio

My love for GSD and dog show experience began in the late 60s. I started in obedience and then moved to conformation. I personally exhibited GSD from puppy class to their championship title; and one to Select 2. It was then later, I began using professional handlers, but I always done my own training and conditioning.

In 1973, I became an AKC judge, having judged internationally in Hong Kong & Mexico and domestically in most States from Alaska, Hawaii, to Florida. In addition, I have lectured on GSD structure, judging procedures, and temperament testing.

My Doctorate was obtained at Oklahoma University in Aerospace & Mechanical Engineering with post-doctoral degree from Princeton University. The Professorial career has been academic and scientific with a joint appointment at the University of Tennessee and Vanderbilt University where I retired as Emeritus Professor after thirty-eight (38) years. I have been participant in the NASA Astronaut Training program and the military program called MOL (Man Orbiting Laboratory former name of the Space Station)

Mr. Alvin Eng – Bio

I started obedience training out of necessity. In 1991, my wife Audrey and I bought our first show puppy. The puppy was a sweet but ill-mannered English Springer Spaniel named Cruiser. In short, he was aptly named, as in "Cruisin' for a Bruisin'." He was quite a handful, so we enrolled in an obedience class.

One thing led to the next and soon Cruiser and I were competing. Cruiser never became a great competitor. However, through dog training I fell in love with Cruiser and the sport of dog obedience. To me, the special bond I forged with Cruiser and my dogs is the best part of dog training. I really love seeing this bond between dog and owner when they work in the ring.

Since Cruiser, I have trained many English Springer Spaniels to obedience and rally titles. One was Cybil, OTCH Gold Mountain's Moonlighting UDX2 RE, who won the US Pupperoni Western Regional Novice Division in 1997. Cybil also won the English Springer Spaniel Field Trial Association's Obedience Springer of the Year in 1999 and competed at the AKC National Obedience Invitational in 2000 and 2001.

I started judging in 2001 and enjoy judging obedience and rally at all dog events. I am active in the English Springer Spaniel Field Trial Association (ESSFTA)—the AKC Parent Club of the Breed—and served on the Board of Governors and as Vice President.

Mr. Steve Dobbins - Bio

I have had German Shepherds in my family since 1961. It wasn't until 1980 before I got my first German Shepherd Dog that I could call my very own. I went through several kennel names before settling on the name of Cimarron.

I have recently finished my 21st and 22nd champions, to go along with my 6th ROM dam. I became a judge in 2005. All things are important to make up that "perfect German Shepherd" but since I have yet to come across the perfect one, the number one thing that gets my attention is movement. Most have said they can follow my judging technique.

Note: Entry fees include an AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3 for each class in which a dog is entered except brace. These fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. See AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2; AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3.-Rally entries include AKC Event Service fee of \$3.50 for first class and \$3 each additional class per Rally Regulations Chapter 1, Section 4.

Returned Checks/Declined Transactions The Event Secretary will add a \$25 service charge for each returned check or declined credit card transaction. Subsequent invalid payments from the same exhibitor may result in being placed on a CASH ONLY basis.

Refunds Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience, Rally or Junior Showmanship. If a bitch is withdrawn from such competition because she came into season and trial secretary is notified in writing at least one-half hour prior to the start of the event, the club will refund entries withdrawn under this section, but may retain \$5 per class fee. See AKC Obedience Regulations Chapter 1, Section 14 and Rally Regulations Chapter 1, Section 13.

Move-ups and Transfers will be accepted for these events but must be received by the event secretary no later than **Monday July 8, 2019 if mailed**. After that time, please email move-up information to the Secretary by **Thursday July 11, 2019**. Hand delivered move-ups will be accepted until 30 minutes prior to the start of judging each day. Phone move-ups and Transfers will not be accepted.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
