NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 and an **AKC Event Service Fee** of \$3.00 for a total of \$3.50, will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Chapter 11, Section 2).

Entry Fees. \$30.00 for first entry of a dog in a regular class, except Puppy Classes and Bred-By Exhibitor which is \$20.00. Each additional entry of the same dog is \$22.00. Recording fees are included.

Entry Not on Official AKC entry forms and photo copies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on reverse side are not acceptable.

Entry Fee Shall Not be Refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or banned from competition by the show committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be given.

Errors in Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if any entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Postmarks on envelopes, time of mailing, Post Office error, etc. are factors that **CANNOT** be taken into account determining whether entries are "in" before closing deadline.

Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Dogs not entered in the show must be on leash or confined to their crates at all times.

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their times are called to be judged.

No Dog May be Permanently Removed from the Show before it is judged except by the consent of the Show Secretary upon a Veterinarian's recommendation of removal.

Effective for All Shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of the entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition provided the transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the start of judging at the Show.

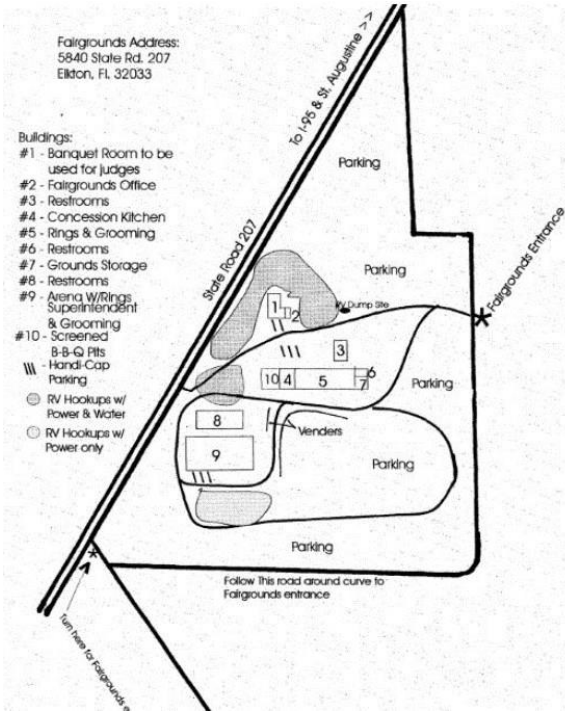

RESERVATION FORM FOR RV HOOKUPS

All RV hookups have water and 30 AMP or 50 AMP service (please specify on the form which one you need). NO piggy backing of power hookups for vans or RVs parked together. This will be strictly enforced. If you are traveling with other RV(s) and wish to park together, reservations must be submitted together. We will do our best to accommodate but we can't guarantee. Gates will open at 12:00 Noon on Thursday, April 5, 2018. Reservations not needed for dry camping. Please bring a hose splitter as some water connections need to be shared. 50 AMP is limited. If you need two 30 AMP outlets you must provide your own splitter. Reservations will be taken in the order received. If you do not make a reservation we can't guarantee electric hookup. If you do not have a reservation it will be first come, first served IF there are any electric hookups left.

Dog shows are fun, family-friendly events. We encourage spectators to walk around, take pictures and ask questions. However, the safety and welfare of a child is the sole responsibility of the child's parent or guardian. It is expressly understood that exhibitors and spectators will exercise control and restraint of their children while at the shows.

The German Shepherd Dog Club of North Florida, Inc., its Board of Directors, the St. Johns County Fairgrounds, their agents and employees (hereafter referred to as "management") assume no risk for any injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, and/or their employees. Entrants and spectators to these shows do so entirely at their own risk.

Management is not responsible for the loss of or damage to the property of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. Management is also not responsible for the loss of, injury to, or death of any dog exhibited. It is expressly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show grounds.

These shows are governed by the rules of the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the official entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information from the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM THE AKC: Exhibitors should follow of their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of a current rabies vaccination must be in the possession of exhibitors or handlers for all dogs at these trials.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
