1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

## ATTENTION PARTICIPANTS AND ATTENDEES: ADDITIONAL RULES RELATED TO COVID-19

Participants and attendees are required to comply with federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and orders required in the jurisdiction of the venue in which the event will take place and should consider whether to also comply with suggested guidelines and best practices that are only recommended. Participants and attendees should also be aware that the locations of their lodging and places they may eat might be in local jurisdictions that are different from the venue for the event.

Participants and attendees should review and comply with the requirements of the American Kennel Club rules and suggested best practices applicable to the event and should consider whether to also comply with suggested guidelines and best practices that are only recommended.

The GSDCA strongly recommends that participants practice social distancing and wear a mask or another face covering suitable for their circumstances even if not required by federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and orders in the jurisdiction of the venue in which the event will take place or the rules of the American Kennel Club. Masks and face coverings will not be provided to participants by the event giving club.

Include the animals you are responsible for (especially those being brought to events) in your social distancing practices. Wash your hands after handling animals, their food, waste, or supplies. Limit interaction with animals not under your control.

Monitor sites like this site maintained by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention for updates and guidance relating to COVID-19 and pets <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/daily-life-coping/pets.html>.

In the 24 - 48 hours prior to the event and prior to your participation on the day of the event, check the GSDCA and AKC websites, plus the website for relevant federal, state and local authorities to familiarize yourself with current rules and procedures.

Bring your own seating and food to better control sanitizing and food preparation. The event giving club may not have any of these items, or enough of them. Clearly mark these things to discourage use by others.

Bring your own masks or other face coverings, hand sanitizer, gloves and tissues. Event giving clubs might not provide these items or they might not be available in sufficient quantities to supply everyone that wants or needs them.

Consider only bringing people to the event that are necessary for you to travel to and participate in the event whom you have determined can comply with applicable laws, rules, regulations and orders on their own or at your direction. This will help reduce the number of people at the event and make it easier to practice social distancing and could help limit potential liability for the actions of people that you bring to an event or venue.

Consider parking your vehicle so that the working end of your vehicle is at the opposite end of the vehicles beside you to create more distance between work areas.

Socialize your dogs to being around and being examined by a person wearing a mask, or to the extent possible, the scent of hand sanitizers. They vary in scent, but many contain alcohol.

Even more than usual, be considerate of how your movements around and near the ring could impact other people who are trying to maintain social distancing.

Conduct that violates required COVID-19 related, federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations, and orders, or required AKC, or the rules of an event giving club could result in referrals to a bench show, or other event, committee and/or the GSDCA ethics committee

No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent

# Face Covering FAQ

## #MaskUpMesa

### **When does Mesa's face covering proclamation go into effect?**

Monday, June 22, 2020 at 8 a.m.

### **I have a medical exemption; do I need a doctor's note?**

No, those who cannot wear face coverings due to a medical, mental health, developmental condition; inability to remove the face mask without assistance or anyone who cannot wear face coverings under CDC guidance, do not have to have a doctor's note and are not required to produce one

### **Do kids have to wear face coverings?**

Yes, children ages six and up are required to wear face coverings when physical distancing cannot be safely maintained.

### **Will kids have to wear face coverings at school?**

The elected governing bodies of our school districts will determine the policies of face coverings in the classroom in accordance with the Fourth Proclamation issued June 20, 2020 and the Maricopa County regulations issued June 19, 2020.

### **Why are churches exempt from the requirement of face coverings?**

While the use of face coverings and physical distancing at church is highly recommended, it is not included in the proclamation due to federal protections.

### **Do I have to wear a face covering while outdoors?**

No, face coverings are not required while exercising, walking or spending time outside as long as physical distancing of six feet is maintained between you and anyone that is not a part of your household. If you're walking or exercising outside with members of your own household, you do not need to wear a face covering even if you are within six feet from one another.

### **Do I have to wear a face covering while swimming?**

No, face coverings are not required while swimming, but physical distancing should be maintained. Face coverings are required in locker rooms.

### **Do I have to wear a face covering at the gym?**

Face coverings are not required while actually engaging in physical activity at the gym or other indoor exercising facility. Face coverings are required at all times when not actually engaged in exercising. For example, face coverings are required when entering, exiting and in the locker room.

**Do I have to wear a face covering while shopping?**

Yes, face coverings are required while entering, exiting, waiting in line to enter, and while inside places of business including, but not limited to, grocery stores, retail stores, pharmacies, health care facilities, restaurants and bars (including outdoor seating for such facilities), hotels and motels (excluding the rented room or suite), gyms and similar facilities.

**Do I have to wear a face covering while at a bar or restaurant?**

Yes, face coverings are required while entering, exiting, waiting for a table and ordering. Face coverings can be removed while eating or drinking but must be worn otherwise. If a patron is not seated at their table or at the bar, a face covering is required.

**Do I have to wear a face covering at work?**

If you interact with the public while at work, a face covering is required. If you do not interact with the public while at work, physical distancing of at least six feet is recommended with your co-workers but you do not need to wear a face covering.

**Do I have to wear a face covering in my car?**

No, face coverings are not required while inside a personal or commercial vehicle that is not a public transportation vehicle, taxi, or ride sharing service. It is recommended to wear a face covering if you cannot maintain six feet of physical distancing between you and someone who is not a member of your household.

**Where can I get a face covering?**

Face coverings are widely available at retailers in Mesa. You can also use a bandana, scarf or piece of fabric as a face covering. Here is information from the Centers for Disease Control on how to make and wear face coverings, <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/how-to-make-cloth-face-covering.html>.

**Can I carry a concealed weapon and wear a face covering?**

Yes, face coverings can be worn while carrying a concealed weapon. If a crime is committed while concealing your identity with a face covering of any kind, it may be an aggravating factor at the time of sentencing if convicted for that crime.

**What are the consequences for not wearing a face covering?**

The enforcement of this proclamation is not designed to be punitive. Enforcement will begin with education and may increase to fines or more, depending on the circumstance and severity of the violation(s).

**When does the requirement expire?**

The proclamation is in effect until it is terminated by the Mayor or until the Governor revokes the authorization given to cities.
