Move-Ups

Request for move-ups must be made in writing and presented to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Both Obedience and Rally Trial move-ups will be accepted as space permits within entry limits, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Forms may be downloaded from the AKC website (www.akc.org) or you may request a move-up form from the Show Secretary.

Notice to Exhibitors

- **Make all checks and money orders payable** to the German Shepherd Dog Club of Western PA (GSDC of WPA)

- **Post Dated and Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry and the Show Secretary will add a \$15.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check
- **Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries cannot be accepted.** Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- **Express mail** entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address.
- **Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.
- **No refund for duplicate entries.** Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- **Owners are responsible** for errors in making out entry forms. Please type or clearly print the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.
- **No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **No entry fee** will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Show Committee.
- **No refunds for Bitches in Season**
- **The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this match, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all portions safely.
- **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. 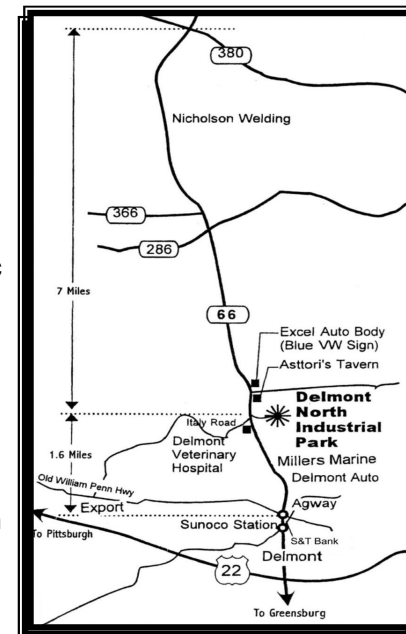
From the South or East
