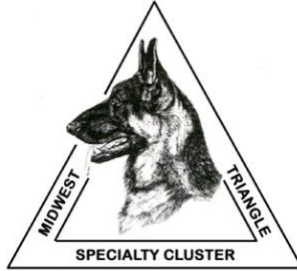

Trophies will be awarded each day. All trophies will be listed in the respective clubs' show catalogs. Prior to the show, interested parties may contact the show secretaries for a list of trophies (when available).

**Exhibitors are reminded that they should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have all appropriate vaccinations.**

## **BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS**

Effective September 18, 2002: 1) All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC; 2) The individual handling the dog in the Bred-By Class must be a breeder of record and a current owner of record of the dog; 3) To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-By Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog.

### **Class Information 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy**

#### **Class – 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy**

The 4-6 Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. (Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.)

#### **4-6 Month Class will NOT be divided by sex.**

#### **Judging**

- Individuals that have an AKC conformation judge's number are the required judges for the Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition. Judges assigned regular classes may not judge the Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition if it interferes or delays the judging of regular classes, Groups or Best in Show. The judging conflict requirements of 30 days and 200 mile between assignments will not apply to the Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition. A change in the listed judge due to an overload will not result in a return in the entry fee.
- Visiting judges are not eligible to judge 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy competition.
- Judges will be credited with an enriching component for breeds judged in the 4-to-6 Month Puppy competition. Judges of this competition may also exhibit on the day(s) they judge.
- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs. Judges will comply with the Rules, Policies and Guidelines for Conformation Judges except the speed of judging may be reduced to 20 dogs an hour.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-to-6 Month Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

## **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS**

Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the clubs nor show secretaries will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class being judged. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the judging of a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dog(s) in the judging ring.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or a judge; or barred from competition due to their violation of any rules or regulations set forth by the show-giving clubs.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by electronic mail, telegram or fax prior to the close of entries. Entries received by telephone are not acceptable.

No fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the show-giving club or show secretary.

The show-giving clubs, the show secretaries, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and, further, no responsibility for injury to children.

An Event Service Fee of \$3.00 and a Recording Fee of \$.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to The American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Rule, Chapter 15, Section 2).

**ALL videotaping or photography during the show requires permission from the show-giving club. Only the Official Show Photographer is allowed to photograph win photos.**

ALL prizes must be claimed the day of the show—none will be mailed.

NO SMOKING is allowed in the Happy Tails Ranch facility.

NO SPACE PROVIDED for unentered dogs.

### **BELOW ARE RULES THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED:**

1. ALL DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, both at the show site and at area hotels (if so designated).
2. Dogs must be kept on leash at all times while on show or hotel grounds.
3. Limit of 2 dogs per hotel room (unless otherwise specified by respective hotels). Plastic (if available at check-in) is to be placed under each crate in hotel room.
4. Unattended dogs must be crated in hotel rooms.
5. Absolutely no bathing or grooming of dogs is allowed in hotel rooms.
6. Dog owners/agents are responsible for timely clean up and disposal of any waste - both at show grounds and at their respective hotels.
7. Dog owners and/or their agents are personally responsible to area hotels for any damage caused thru their negligence.

## Additional COVID-19 guidelines

3. Crating will be alternated big dogs/little dogs to help keep our distance from each other. Crating inside will be limited and exhibitors are encouraged to crate outside.

**INDEMNIFICATION, WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK** I acknowledge and agree that The German Shepherd Dog Club of America, Inc., the AKC Regional Club or SV Regional club hosting or co-hosting the event, and the American Kennel Club, and each of their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, the superintendents and/or event secretary, and the owner and/or lessor or operator of the premises and any provider of services that are used to hold the event(s) and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, other participants, and any judge judging at the event (**collectively, the "Released Parties"**) are participating in te event(s) and allowing me to enter, participate in and/or attend the event(s) **in reliance** on my agreement to this indemnification, waiver of liability and assumption of risk agreement. I understand that The German Shepherd Dog Club of America, Inc. the AKC Regional Club or SV Regional club hosting or co-hosting the event have **the right to refuse** my participation in, or attendance at the event(s), in **consideration of** permitting my participation in, or attendance at the event(s) and of the holding of the event and/or the opportunity to have dogs judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies.

## **ATTENTION PARTICIPANTS AND ATTENDEES: ADDITIONAL RULES RELATED TO COVID-19**

Limit interaction with animals not under your control. Bring your own seating and food to better control sanitizing and food preparation. The event giving club may not have any of these items, or enough of them. Clearly mark these things to discourage use by others. Bring your own masks or other face coverings, hand sanitizer, gloves and tissues. Event giving clubs might not provide these items or they might not be available in sufficient quantities to supply everyone that wants or needs them. Consider only bringing people to the event that are necessary for you to travel to and participate in the event whom you have determined can comply with applicable laws, rules, regulations and orders on their own or at your direction.
