**From New York, (Non-Commercial Vehicles only):** Merritt Parkway, (Rte. 15) to Exit 49S, (Rte. 25 S). Follow Rte. 25 south to exit 6, (Old Town Rd.). Turn left onto Old Town Rd. Go to the second traffic light, (White Plains Rd.) and turn left onto White Plains Rd. Go about .9 miles and Unity Park will be on the left immediately before the Route 15 overpass. Follow Unity Park Rd. to the back of the park passing the ballfields.

**From New York or Hartford:** Interstate 95 to Exit 27A, (Rte. 8/25 N). Follow highway until Rte. 25 and Rte. 8 split, (left 3 lanes become Rte. 25 north). Follow Rte. 25 to exit 7. Bear right on ramp to White Plains Rd. Turn right onto White Plains Road. Go about .6 miles and Unity Park will be on the right immediately after the Route 15 overpass. Follow Unity Park Rd. to the back of the park passing the ballfields.
