**SEVERAL CHANGES** have been made to this year's premium list. You are advised to read it carefully and follow all the instructions. There is a new **FILLABLE ENTRY FORM** available to make your entries smoother and faster to submit. The AKC has stated that **NO ENTRIES** are to be accepted **WITHOUT SIGNATURES**. Please be sure to sign, electronically sign or authorize Show Secretary to sign your phoned in entry form and provide correct information. **ENTRY FORMS ARE NOW FILLABLE**. You can request a premium list and entry form by e-mail. Please use the entry form for these shows, download and save it to your device. Fill in the information and save the form on your device (I recommend using the dog's AKC # or the dog's call name as the name of the filled in form). Once it is saved, then e-mail it to me at [showsecretary@anarak.org](mailto:showsecretary@anarak.org) ! If you are paying via PayPal or Square, there is a \$2.50 per dog/per event handling fee. (i.e., a dog entered in both Conformation Shows on same day will require an additional \$5.00/per day.) **ALL PAYMENTS** by check are to be made to **ANN AKERILL, NOT THE INDIVIDUAL CLUB**. Make sure your check is filled out correctly and your amounts are correct. Feel free to call if you need help determining what amount to send!

If you have provided us with your e-mail address, you will receive your acknowledgement via e-mail. This is in an attempt to keep costs down for our clubs which, in turn, keeps the cost of your entries down.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures
- Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received writing or by email prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
- EXHIBITORS NOTE: Please notify Show Secretary of change of address.

- Exhibitors who owe monies to the Club may have their entries returned and not accepted.
- If an entry is sent by any express mail carrier, please check the "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED" box.
- All dogs on show site must have proof of current rabies vaccination (within one year of show date). Tags do not constitute proof of vaccination.
- Use one form per dog. Check at the top of the entry form the shows in which you want your dog entered. If you wish to enter a dog in different classes on different days, you must use a separate entry form for each day.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary.
- Dogs, which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a Championship after closing of entries, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging.
- The show-giving club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs

or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

- The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control of and restraint over their children while attending these shows.

- There will be no refund for duplicate entries.
- Dogs need to be present for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the present of their dogs in the judging rings.
- The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money order issued in U.S. funds.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSIFICATION

### **FRIDAY, 2/24/17 & SATURDAY a.m. 2/25/17 - Collie Club of Washington offers the following Junior Showmanship Classes:**

**Novice Jr. Class:** For boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who. at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Intermediate Class:** For boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who. at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show

**Novice Sr. Class:** For boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who. at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show

**Open Class:** For boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who. at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in the Novice Class.

**Open Class:** For boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who. at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in the Novice Class.

**Open Class:** For boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who. at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in the Novice Class.

**Master Class:** For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year.

*All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.*

**Best Junior Handler:** Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.
