SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ALL Classes Divided by sex)

The Sweepstakes shall be open to all GSDs eligible whose age will be no less than six months and no greater than eighteen months on the day of judging. Champions of record are eligible, provided they meet the age requirements. No restrictions on professional handlers.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all GSDs 7 years of age and older as of the day of the show. Enter Veteran Sweepstakes as an additional class. Open to Champions, neutered dogs, and spayed bitches, if they are within the age limits. Veteran Dogs or Bitches, 7 to 9 years, 9 to 12 years, 12 years and older.

No restrictions on professional handlers.

- 2. If within 14 days prior to the trials you have been in the presence of a person who has either tested positive for COVID-19 or has the symptoms noted above, please stay home.
- 3. **PHYSICAL DISTANCING**: Maintain at least 6 feet between you and other exhibitors or spectators at all times. Avoid congregating to the extent possible. Avoid physical contact (shaking hands or hugging). Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
- 4. **FACE MASKS:** Per State of California health orders, face masks are required at all times while outside of one's home where physical distancing is not possible. Participants at this event must supply their own masks.
- 5. **<u>PARKING</u>**; Park with increased distance between vehicles whenever possible.
